RULES OF THE RTVA AWARD TO THE ANDALUSIAN AUDIOVISUAL CREATION OF FANTASTIC GENRE

- 1.- Aims. RTVA and Málaga University's International Week of Fantastic Film have among their aims to contribute to andalusian audiovisual development, and encourage creativity of young andalusian creators. The RTVA Award will be ruled by these requirements and the agreement between RTVA and the University of Málaga dated November 16th, 2006.
- 2.- General Conditions. Works in the competition will fall into the fantastic genre and its variations (horror, science fiction, thriller). The audiovisual works presented in the competition must fulfil the following requirements:
 - A maximum length of 20 minutes.
 - Must be made in any of the following formats: 35 and 16 mm, and High-definition (HD) digital video.
 - Their production must have been completed no more than
 18 months before the closing of the enrolment.
- A maximum of two works per producer will be accepted in competition.
 - They will be presented in their original versions, and those whose original language is not Spanish must be printed with subtitles.
- 3.- Participants. Eligible participants in the competition include any producer who lives in the Andalusian autonomous region, was born in or currently resides there, and could legally demonstrate this, and possesses royalties of the audiovisual work in any of its formats presented in competition.
- 4.- Enrolment. Producers interested in presenting their works in competition must submit the following documents before January 20th, 2006.
 - Official enrolment form filled out in its entirety.
 - Participants must send a copy of the work in competition in DVD or VHS-PAL, with the title, director, and length, as well as some photographs of different scenes of the work for its inclusion in the general catalogue.

- 5.- Transport. Transportation expenses of the copy and materials will be paid by the participant.
- 6.- Jury. The official Jury of the IWFF will award the RTVA award to the Andalusian Audiovisual Creation of Fantastic Genre. Decisions of the Jury will be final.

People in charge of the selection and direction of the IWFF may refuse, once presented, those audiovisual works that in their opinion do not fulfil the appropriate technical requirements of its correct public exhibition.

7.- Distribution and Information. Participating producers in the RTVA Award to the Andalusian Audiovisual Creation of Fantastic Genre authorize by presenting the enrolment form, the use of one or more extract of their work to be distributed as publicity material in the media.

Producers of the selected shorts will give a copy of those to the RTVA and an additional copy to the IWFF archives.

- 8.- Award. An award and trophy have been established as follows:
- RTVA Award to the **Best Andalusian Audiovisual Creation** of Fantastic Genre provided with 1,500 euros.
- Trophy, a bronze reproduction of the sculpture "El Dilema".

In no case shall the award be declared as "ex aeguo".

All selected works will receive a diploma of accreditation as recognition on the part of the organisation.

Winning the award involves the broadcasting of the work on any RTVA channel, to do that a three years broadcasting rights contract without exclusive rights must be signed. Signing the contract is an essential requirement for the collection of the award money which will be subjected to current taxes. Accepting the award money and signing the contract will signify the transferring of rights for the duration of the contract.

The winning short film producer will commit themselves to including a reference to the 16th IWFF and the RTVA award to the Andalusian Audiovisual Creation of Fantastic Genre, as well as the logo of the IWFF, in all the copies they may distribute for its exhibition, and also in informational and promotional printed material.

9.- Participating in the competition involves acceptance of these requirements.
